We have reached a tentative deal!

We have recently finished the mediation process with the Government of Nunavut and your Bargaining Team was successful in reaching a tentative agreement.

It has been a full two years of hard negotiations for your bargaining team as they had to fight for every inch and to get rid of just about all of the concessions (i.e. giving up your benefits) the employer tried to force on you, the members.

In the coming weeks a ratification kit outlining the changes to the Collective Agreement will be made available on our website and we will be holding a ratification meetings and votes.

A big shout-out goes out to the Bargaining Team members Jennifer Pearce, Abe Qammaniq, Rob Hogan, Rick Roberts and Linda Hunter for their determination in reaching this Tentative Agreement that they recommend unanimously.

Bill Fennell congratulated the team on a job well done. He also noted that “The employer never really came to the table for the first year of negotiations, frustrating the entire bargaining unit.”

“After a long round of bargaining, I’m happy to hear a tentative agreement has been reached. Now our members can focus on what they do best, which is to provide quality services to Nunavummiuts”, says Jack Bourassa, Regional Executive Vice President for the PSAC North.
