Greetings NEU Members!

This message is a call for the election of Regional Vice-Presidents and their Alternates for the regions listed above. These regional elections take place among all NEU members in the NEU regions as defined below.

Who can run for NEU Regional Vice-President and Alternate?

Any NEU member in good standing who lives and works in their region can be nominated.

What is an NEU Regional Vice-President (RVP) and what do they do?

NEU Regional Vice-Presidents sit on the executive of the Nunavut Employees Union to represent their region in the governing and decision-making of the Union, attend all meetings of the NEU executive and support all the locals and communities in their regions.

An RVP can expect to travel to Iqaluit (usually) for executive meetings and to other communities in their regions.

It is important that every region be represented on the NEU executive so that voices from across Nunavut will be heard in your Union.

Alternate RVPs support the work of the RVPs and replace them if there is a vacancy.

How do the elections happen?

According to NEU By-Law 12, Section 4, the Regional Vice-Presidents and Alternate Regional Vice-Presidents are nominated and elected by NEU members of their respective region by a secret ballot.

There are four open RVP positions, and four Alternate RVP positions as follows:

- <u>Kitikmeot West (new region)</u>: Cambridge Bay and Kugluktuk
- <u>Baffin South (vacant)</u>: Kinngait, Kimmirut, Ottawa and Sanikiluaq
- <u>Baffin Centre (vacant)</u>: Clyde River, Pangnirtung, Pond Inlet and Qikiqtarjuaq
- <u>Kivalliq South (vacant)</u>: Arviat, Churchill, Rankin Inlet, Whale Cove and Winnipeg
- Nunavut Capital Region: Iqaluit

Nominations **must** be received in the NEU office by 5:00 pm MDT on February 23, 2024. If an election is required, ballots will then be sent to every NEU member in that region whose personal emails NEU has.

members in good standing. <u>Emails containing the same information</u> <u>as the forms will be accepted.</u>
